Entry Fee - \$50.00 per team if entry is received by January 20th. \$60 per team for walk-in entries and all entries received after January 20th. The additional \$10 per team will be added to the prize fund.

Entry Fee Breakdown (Based on 26 Teams) Lineage \$22.50, Expenses \$2, Prize Fund \$25.50.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Doubles Event
4 Game qualifying format.
Top 7 scores advance to the playoffs (based on a minimum 26 teams, if less than 26 the cut may be adjusted.)
Playoff format is single elimination 1 game matches.
Highest qualifying team will get 1st round bye.
Quarter-Final matches seeds 2 vs. 7, 3 vs. 6, 4 vs. 5.(if 7 teams)
Semi-Final matches have the 1 seed vs. lowest seed & middle seeds play each other.
Winners will play for Championship.

PRIZE FUND - All Teams making the cut will receive scholarship funds.

Eligibility: Open to all MCUSBC Youth Bowlers . Entering average (21 game minimum) will be (in order of priority) 1) 2017-2018 House Shot Winter League or High School Average. 2) 2018 Summer League Average.3) 2017-2018 Sport Adjusted Winter League Average. 4) Current league or high school average as of 12-31-18. If none of the above than bowler must enter with 220. **ONE YOUTH BOWLER MUST HAVE AN AVERAGE OF 165 AND UNDER. THE OTHER YOUTH BOWLER MUST BE 166 AND OVER.**

Rules: This is a handicap tournament. The handicap will be 80% of the difference of the team average vs. scratch score of 400. All averages will be verified. If any average submitted is found lower than the actual average, the scores may be disqualified. If submitted average is higher, then any prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. **It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify their average.**

Additional Rules and Regulations

1. To be eligible all bowlers must be certified with Monmouth County USBC This includes all High School bowlers certified in Monmouth County. Out of County bowlers are eligible however they must sanction in Monmouth County. Membership is \$6 and we will be taking payment for membership at the event.
2. Entries will be scheduled in the order received. This tournament is limited to 26 teams. The Tournament Manager will assign lanes.
3. Bowler or Parent is responsible for submitting correct information. Any protest affecting eligibility, or general playing rules, must be confirmed in writing to a Tournament Official. Errors must be reported to the Tournament Manager within 24 hours.
4. All entries must be submitted on an Official Entry Blank. Bowlers will compete in the order as submitted on the form. Bowlers must report 30 minutes prior to their scheduled start time.
5. There will be no altering of ball surfaces once competition begins. Bowlers may not alter surfaces in between rounds.
6. **PREMATURE TERMINATION OF TOURNAMENT:** Brought about by war, terrorism, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond control of MCBA shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.
7. The Tournament Director reserves all rights and the decision of the tournament director shall be final in accordance with Rule 329.
8. Trophies will be awarded to winners at the Annual County Banquet. Tickets to the banquet will be complimentary for all of our tournament winners.
9. **Eligibility for the 2019 MCSUBC Youth Masters Tournament-** 1) All MCUSBC Youth bowlers with 21 or more games will be eligible to compete. 2) All Other USBC Youth bowlers that have competed in at least 2 MCUSBC Youth Tournaments during the 2018- 2019 Bowling Season will also be eligible to compete.
